Suicide does not discriminate

Suicide is the 10th leading cause of death in the U.S. with 132 individuals dying by suicide per day.

Ethnicity per 100,000 individuals:

Men:



3.56x more likely to die by suicide

Women:



1.4x more likely to attempt suicide

LGBTQ youth:

~5x as likely to have attempted suicide compared to heterosexual youth

Transgender adults:

40% report having made a suicide attempt
